I. Organizer

« "ANDREI NICOLESCU" Cup» contest is organized by **CLUB SPORTIV AQUA SPORT CITIUS BUCURESTI.**

The participants to the contest shall observe the terms and conditions in these Official Contest Rules.

The Official Contest Rules shall be drawn up and made public in accordance with the legislation in force in Romania, and it shall be available for free for each applicant on Organizer's website and at the place where the contest takes place.

The contest shall be organized in compliance with FINA – International Swimming Federation Contest Rules, and the competitors shall observe the rules presented in FINA rules. FINA rules may be read on the official website of the International Swimming Federation (FINA)

By taking part in this competition, the participants agree to comply with and observe all the provisions, terms and conditions of these Official Contest Rules and of the legislation in force.

II. Period and place of contest

The contest shall take place in the period October 26-27, 2019 at Dinamo Olympic Swimming Pool (Bucharest, Şoseaua Ştefan cel Mare, nr. 7-9).

The swimming pool is 50 m long and it has 10 lanes. Water temperature is 26-28 degrees Celsius. Timekeeping is automatic.

III. Participants

The categories of participants are:

Boys: 2010 and younger, 2009, 2008, 2007, 2006, 2005-2004 (the winning ceremony for boys born in 2005 and 2004 will not be separated)

Girls: 2010 and younger, 2009, 2008, 2007, 2006-2005 (the winning ceremony for girls born in 2006 and 2005 will not be separated)

The competitors falling into the categories specified in these Rules and who registered and paid the contest fees may take part in this Contest. Those born in 2011, 2012 will be awarded together with those born in 2010 and have to accomplish the target times for 2010.

The maximum number of participants shall be **400**. When this figure has been touched, registrations shall stop.

Each club shall be responsible for the health of their participants in the contest. They must have a medical visa to date, and the verification of this visa shall be incumbent on the participating club. The participation to this contest shall be the responsibility of each competitor and club, respectively.

IV. Registration

The registration lists shall be sent via e-mail until **October 13, 2019** to the address mircea.purcaru@aqua-sport.ro.

Withdrawals shall be made until October 18th, 2019 at the latest.

The registration deadline shall be mandatory.

A child may take part to maximum 2 events of each meeting. The system creating the series is automatic. Series shall be OPEN in qualifications.

We reserve the right to change the start time according to the number of registrations received.

The organizing club undertakes, within 24 hours since the receiving of the registration list, to send a confirmation e-mail. If this is not the case, they shall consider that the respective registration list has not been received, and the participating club shall have to resend the registration list.

The start lists shall be completed within at least 48 hours before the beginning of the contest. These and the real time results may be followed by accessing the website www.lpin.ro.

V. Participation fee

The participation fee shall be 130 RON/participant.

The fee may be paid in cash before the official beginning of the contest or by bank transfer to the account RO93BACX0000001098609003 – open with UNICREDIT BANK, beneficiary Asociaţia Club Sportiv AQUA SPORT CITIUS BUCURESTI.

The fee for each club shall be calculated according to the final list on **October 18th**, **2019** which shall become exigible from now on, regardless whether a participant withdraws subsequently

VI. Rules and conditions

The first 8 athletes in each event shall qualify to the event finals in the afternoon. The finals shall be constituted by ages. If there are 8 participants or fewer for the same event, the athletes shall no longer participate to qualifications and they shall qualify directly for the finals.

In the event no. 5, 200 m CRAZY Individual Medley, during the qualifications, the swimmers will have to respect the order of the styles mentioned in the FINA rules whereas in the finals, the 8th qualified swimmers will extract the order of the styles right before the start of the race, each swimmer having a unique combination. In this event are not permited flip turns after freestyle. The only turns permited are those permited in classical race 200m medley.



If there are more than 2 athletes from the same club they shall not qualify for the same finals.

If 3 or more athletes from the same club have obtained a time allowing them to qualify for the finals, the first 2 shall qualify, and the rest of them shall be replaced with athletes from other clubs in the order of qualification times

If 2 or more athletes are on a par on the 8th place, they shall be subject to a tiebreaker consisting in the repeating of the event.

In finals will take place the Generation's relay race 10x50 freestyle. Each club can enter the competition with maximum one relay. Each relay will consist of 5 boys and 5 girls. Each relay will have one swimmer of each age:

- One swimmer born in 2010-2011
- One swimmer born in 2009
- One swimmer born in 2008
- One swimmer born in 2007
- One swimmer born in 2006
- One swimmer born in 2005
- 4 swimmers for each club, regardless of age.

Finalists in each event, according to the place they occupy, shall also receive a number of points as follows:

1st place – 9 points; 2nd place – 7 points; 3rd place – 6 points; 4th place – 5 points; 5th place – 4 points; 6th place – 3 points; 7th place – 2 points; 8th place -1 point; relay races shall be scored triple.

The most valuable athlete based on the score accumulated for each age and gender category and the first 3 clubs in the overall ranking shall be awarded diplomas and cups and special prizes.

Each event has a target time. In the case that the target time is not achieved in the competition, the club has to pay a penalty fee of 50 RON/event. The target times are presented in the next table:

VII. Other observations

Each participating club shall have a number of seats allocated in the tribune proportionally to the number of participants.

By their registration to the contest, the participating delegations agree to the taking of photos/filming of the participant athletes and to the use of the audio-video data for commercial purposes.

Each club must send the name of their assigned photographer at mircea.purcaru@aqua-sport.ro, by October 18, 2019 and the access will be permited only with the badge offered by the organizer. Any person who will take photographies from the border of the swimming pool, including coaches/professional photographers/etc will make sure to give priority to the official photographers and video operators of the competition and will make sure that they don't interefere with their access at any point. Failing to comply with this condition may end-up with the exclusion of the person from the border of the swimming pool. All images (photo or video) taken from the border of the swimming pool and published on Social Media must include: the name of the Competition Cupa Andrei Nicolescu, ediţia a III-a and the name of the organizer Aqua Sport. All images (photo or video) taken from the border of the swimming pool and published on Facebook must tag the event name Cupa Andrei Nicolescu, ediţia a III-a and Aqua Sport's official Facebook page: https://www.facebook.com/AquaSport09

If extraordinary situations that prevent the safe carrying out of the event (e.g. extreme weather conditions) may occur, situations that may not be foreseen, the event shall be postponed or even cancelled.

The participation to the contest/event of the persons having alcoholic drinks/drugs on them or who are intoxicated by them, of the persons having any kind of weapons, explosive or fire materials, irritating-teargas substances or substances having a paralyzing effect, electric shock devices or any other objects on them that may be used for violent actions or for the disturbance of the normal carrying out of the event shall be forbidden. The persons who breach these provisions shall be eliminated from the event area by the organisers, even with the help of the law enforcement, if necessary.




